Chili Community Center: The Committee reviewed the preliminary plan for the proposed project, no drainage issues were shown or discussed.

The existing site condition is 100 % paved, a portion of the development area will include landscaped islands and storm water control features. All site drainage will continue to flow to the existing storm drainage system serving the entire Plaza.

20 Black Creek Rd. Rochester Community Inclusive Rowing: The site is adjacent to existing State Land with public access along Black Creek. Drainage issues will be subject to routine rain events, and the proximity to regular drainage into Black creek. The Committee had no drainage concerns with the application.
