OLD BUSINESS:

- Peter researched sign purchase: Franklin Bronze Plaques or Lamont Trophies in Spencerport. Lamont Trophies requires no W9 forms, etc. Bronze could cost \$700 Possible placement of the information-- On a post, on rock in garden, bronze. Plastic or laminate is needed for wooden or fiber so that no woodpeckers destroy it. Bonnie is waiting to hear back from David Lindsay who is out of town. Finance possibilities: Fund raiser, donations, private citizen donation. More clarification needed from David or Dawn. "Friends of library" etc. have raised funds.
- Peter researched the location of early town meetings which were held in homes--Checkered Tavern at Morgan and Scottsville-Chili Road/ James Coleman House in 1822, 2nd location in 1824 was home of Benjamin Bowen Union Street/In 1935 Chili Fire House Number 1 near old Senior Center/1950 behind new Highway Department/ 3235 Chili Ave. 1960 town hall 3235. Current townhall was land donated by Wegmans 1998. First official 1822-1823 town meeting at James Coleman's home Union and Chili Ave. Burned in 1950s.
- Proposed Map-pin location. Peter wants to do the cemeteries. Chris Levey will put it up. Pete has a scavenger hunt already created.
- Facebook. Lynsey has reached out to Chris Levy, but hasn't heard back yet. She will email him.
- Copies and update of code 304-- James said it has been approved. Peter will check with Dawn for the code changes.
