Minutes:

Pat Tindale made the motion that the minutes of the September 13, 2021 meeting of the Chili Conservation Board be approved. The motion was seconded by Dick Schickler.

Liaison Reports:

Town Board:

Mark DeCory reminded the Conservation Board that the Town of Chili will celebrate their 200th anniversary in 2022 with various activities. Mark is on a committee that will be making some of those plans.

The Town Board meeting next week will be discussing the town budget.

Monroe County Environmental Management Council

Larry Lazenby reported on the September EMC meeting. Some of the topics included:

- Invasive species: Emerald Ash Borer and bamboo.
- Increasing numbers of small solar systems on individual homes and businesses.
- EcoPark has experienced record usage.
- Ban on foam clamshells and Styrofoam peanuts for packing will go into effect in January 2022.
- Garbage companies are having a difficult time hiring drivers, which has resulted in slow garbage pickup in some areas.
