Date	Issue/Concern	Discussion/Actions Taken
Jan. 3, 2019 Item #1	Concerns were raised from the committee regarding posted speed limits being too low and improper pavement markings existing on several rural roads in the town.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Chili Highway Department will work with the Monroe County Department of Transportation to complete a speed and pavement marking assessment on Ballantyne Rd, Humphrey Rd, Bowen Rd, Stryker Rd. and Reed Rd. Copies of the written correspondence can be found in the meeting minutes of Nov. 7, 2019 • [Aug 6, 2020] MCDOT will review the needed work given that there was a delay in many projects relating to the governor's pandemic orders. • [Sept 3] Time/Resources need to be allocated. • [Nov 5] Restating that this issue is contingent on time and resource needs. • [Dec 3] This will more than likely happen in the Spring. • [Jan 7, 2021] Town and County will work on a pavement marking study as time and resources permit. • [Feb 4] Review and assessment of striping reasons from the past to better determine the needs for changes • [Apr 1] Review of jobs and needs has begun. The expectation is that a list of roads will be compiled for changes. Approved changes in striping will occur when resurfacing is conducted on designated roads. • [May 6] County and town are working on a schedule of work • [Jun 3] Planning for this task is being determined to coincide with work being done by the County. • [Aug 5] Waiting for status update from County • [Sept 2] Waiting for the Passing Zone Assessment to be completed by the County. A strong possibility that the new posted speed limit signs will not be completed until Spring 2022. • [Nov 7] County has yet to finish its Passing Zone assessment. • [Jan 6, 2022] No discussion • [Mar 3] County plans to conclude the assessment plan in May 2022. • [Apr 7] On schedule for May 2022

Any road not completed will be completed in the Spring when weather improves • [Nov 3] Conclusion of project is contingent on weather conditions • [Dec 1] Town and County coordinating plans to finish up work late Spring/early Summer • [Jan 5] No additional information
<p>Aug 4, 2022</p> <p>Item #1</p>	<p>Town citizens informed the committee that they have a concern with the intersection of Beaver Rd./Beaver Rd. Ext, and Flinton Run.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There have been multiple accidents at the intersection of Beaver Rd./Beaver Rd. Ext, and Finton Run. This is one of the newer town intersections that involves the Rose Hill Estates development. The concerned citizens are aware that the road is a state road and any engineering or installation of stop lights is completely at the discretion of the NYSDOT. After discussion, the committee will investigate improvements for this intersection specific to signage and sight lines. The committee will make a recommendation to the Town Highway department for any needed actions. • [Sept 1] Discussion and no additional action. • [Oct. 6] Town is working on street signage and foliage trimming. • [Nov 6] Town will reach out to NYSDOT to confirm signage and request placement where needed. • [Dec 1] Awaiting response from NYSDOT. • [Jan 5] No additional information
<p>Aug 4, 2022</p> <p>Item #2</p>	<p>Committee member Michael Tata raised awareness to the possible blind spot/obscured view of traffic when existing Black Creek Park.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There are several signs that make it difficult to adequately see southbound traffic on Union Street when exiting the park. • [Sept 1] Discussion and no additional action. • [Oct. 6] County will look into sign placements. • [Nov 3] County plans to review/assess concerns in the coming days. • [Dec 1] County planning to correct the signs and place on job schedule. • [Jan 5] Work is believed to be complete; not confirmed.
<p>Aug 4, 2022</p> <p>Item #3</p>	<p>Committee member Stephen Tarbell raised awareness of an issue with the sidewalk along Union Street.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The sidewalk was initially paved with asphalt and that the sidewalk as greatly deteriorated. The committee will review the complaint and suggest an action to the appropriate agency having jurisdiction. • [Sept 1] Discussion and no additional action. • [Oct. 6] Town will look into the possibilities of replacing/updating the sidewalk. • [Nov 3] Town will look at budget needs and work for late spring/early summer.

Dec 1, 2022 Issue #2	Brent Penwarden, County DOT received a complaint specific to the intersection of Morgan Rd. and Union St regarding sight lines/distance.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • County will be investigating the need to trim foliage and perform other assessments at this intersection to improve sight lines/distance. • [Jan 5] Code officer will follow up with property owner


